Circular Creatives will upskill creative entrepreneurs and aspiring creatives as well as VET educators and trainers to embrace the principles of the circular economy. It will help them to adapt to a more sustainable business model that reduces costs and waste while protecting and creating jobs.

Circular Creatives is based on the reality that the creative industry will not return to its pre-pandemic peak unless a new way of supporting and upskilling creatives for modern business and future employment needs are introduced. Amid the economic crisis of the last two years, there has been a growing call for new ways of doing business and to future-proof the creative sector going forward. However, skills development is needed to adapt self-employed and unemployed creatives to achieve circularity in their professions.
